THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14 Daniel sees One like a Son of man.
Psalm 97 "The Lord is King, the most high over all the earth."
2 Peter 1:16-19 The beloved, in whom God is well pleased.
Matthew 17:1-9 Jesus is transfigured.

Today we hear an eyewitness account of the Transfiguration from Peter himself in our second reading. As we hear his words together with those of the prophet Daniel and the Gospel proclamation, we should pay attention to Peter's admonition that we would do well to be attentive to this prophetic message. So let us attend to these words, and reflect on how Jesus has shown what awaits each of us who follow Him with sincere hearts.
