**Romans 5:1-5** Faith matures into a well-founded hope for God's promised glory.


**John 16:12-15** The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are one in perfect communion.



• Most Holy Trinity: Today we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. The dogma of faith



which forms the object of the feast is this: There is one God and in this one God there are three Divine Persons; the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy




Spirit is God. Yet there are not three Gods, but one, eternal, incomprehensible God! The Father is not more God than the Son, neither is the Son more God than the Holy Spirit. The Father is the first Divine Person; the Son is the second Divine Person, begotten from the nature of the Father from eternity; the Holy Spirit is the third Divine Person, proceeding from the Father and the *Son*.

Almighty and everlasting God, who hast given unto us Thy servants grace by the profession of the true faith, to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and, in the

power of Thy Divine Majesty, to worship the Unity; we beseech Thee, that by our steadfastness in this same faith, we may evermore be defended from all adversities, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

- <u>Congratulations Father Fernan:</u> Today at the 12:00 Mass our *Pastor, Fr. Matthew Fernan*, will be officially installed as the *Fifth Pastor, of Saint Eugene Church* by the Dean of the South Westchester Deanery, *Fr. Robert Grippo*, Pastor of Annunciation/Our Lady of Fatima Parish. *All are invited to join us for a light reception in the Parish Hall immediately following the Mass.* A brief history of Father's Pastoral Life. Father Fernan was ordained May 13, 1989 by *John Cardinal O'Connor*. Father's first assignment was as an Associate Priest at *St. Benedict Church* in the Bronx. Father continued his ministry by working as a teacher and then procurator of *Cardinal Hayes High School* for eight years. Father was then assigned to *Immaculate Heart of Mary* in Scarsdale as Parochial Vicar. After four years, in July of 2004, Father Fernan was elevated to the position of Pastor, and was assigned to the Parishes of *Saint Matthew & Saint Stanislaus Kostka*, in *Hastings on Hudson*. In August of 2013 Father was named Administrator of *Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church* in Ardsley as well as continuing his duties as Pastor of *Saint Matthew*. In his tenure Father has also assisted in many other parishes including, *Saint Margaret, Saint Theresa, and Saint Helena Churches*. Father has served as chaplain of the *Hastings on Hudson VFW, Police, Fire and Southside Club and the* Ardsley *Fire Department*. On June 30, 2015, *Timothy Cardinal Dolan* assigned Father to the Parish of *Saint Eugene* as Pastor effective August 1, 2015. We thank Father Fernan for his dedication to all of his parishioners, and for guiding us as we all try to follow in the footsteps of Our Lord. May God Bless You Father, *Ad Multos Annos*.

## Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity Our Blessed Lady and the Trinity

"In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of



the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. And he came to Her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." But She was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. The angel said to Her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a Son, and you will name Him Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His ancestor David. He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" The angel said to Her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; He will be called Son of God." (Luke 1:26-35)

Revelation is the action, the purpose and the meaning. As we have seen numerous times, since the fall of Adam and Eve, God has been trying to bring us back to that state of sinlessness in which we created and intended to remain. In order for us to return to the Father, The Father has had to reveal Himself to us so that we would get to know, begin to love and choose to be with Him for all eternity. Century after century God the Father revealed Himself in varied ways to His chosen people. Many times they returned and many times they turned away. To return humanity to its intended Divine Intimacy, God had to further reveal His essence to His people striving to be holy. And so the Father in one action revealed not only the Son but also the Spirit... "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God (the Father). And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a Son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High... Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" The angel said to Her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; He will be called Son of God." In this one pivotal moment for all creation, in this one conversation, the Most Holy Trinity has been revealed. How??

God the Father as Creator... "you will conceive in your womb and bear a Son."

God the Son as King and Savior... "He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His ancestor <u>David</u>. He will <u>reign</u> over the house of Jacob forever, and of

His kingdom there will be no end."

God the Holy Spirit as Sanctifier... "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be <u>holy</u>."

And all of this was made possible through one woman. This one woman was able to reestablish the order originally intended by God with God reigning over all. This one woman was able to remind us that God is the original and continual Creator of all. This one woman was able to give us the chance to sanctify ourselves through the gift of Her Son and power of the Spirit, which makes us holy. Our Blessed Lady was chosen by God to reveal the fullness of the Most Holy Trinity. In thanksgiving, we pray to Her today, pleading that She always lead and guide closer to God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
